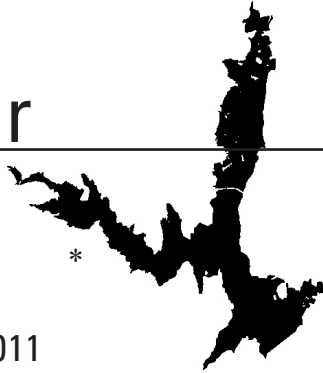

## What you'll want & need to know...

BioBlitz 2011 is being held on the former Joslin Farm site, owned by Providence Water, on the rural west side of the Scituate Reservoir. Site maps, including topography, boundaries & features, are on the RINHS website.

For driving directions... Google "Field Hill Road, Scituate, RI" the BioBlitz site is accessed from the Tunk Hill Road end on the east edge of the parcel. Science Central and camping will be atop Field Hill in the middle of the big field. Parking will be confined to the "lower" field that you pass through upon entering the property, about 1/2 mile from Science Central. You are welcome to drive all the way in to drop gear, but please be courteous and make it quick.

The general rule is that you are responsible for bringing your own camping & field gear, reference materials, etc. RINHS has some scientific & field equipment we can lend, contact us ASAP if you are in need. The Science Central tent will provide generator electricity, extension cords, some lights, tables, and chairs.

Simple amenities included with your \$15 registration:

- dinner Friday & continental breakfast Saturday - given the Saturday end time of 3pm, you may want to bring additional sustenance.
- camping space, port-a-johns, hand washing station
- coffee & tea fixings and potable water will be available for the duration of the event - remember to bring along your travel mug & refillable water bottle.

Our host rules and regulations vary from year to year. Following are the rules for this year, we anticipate you will all be respectful and adhere to them. Thanks in advance!

- \* NO alcohol
